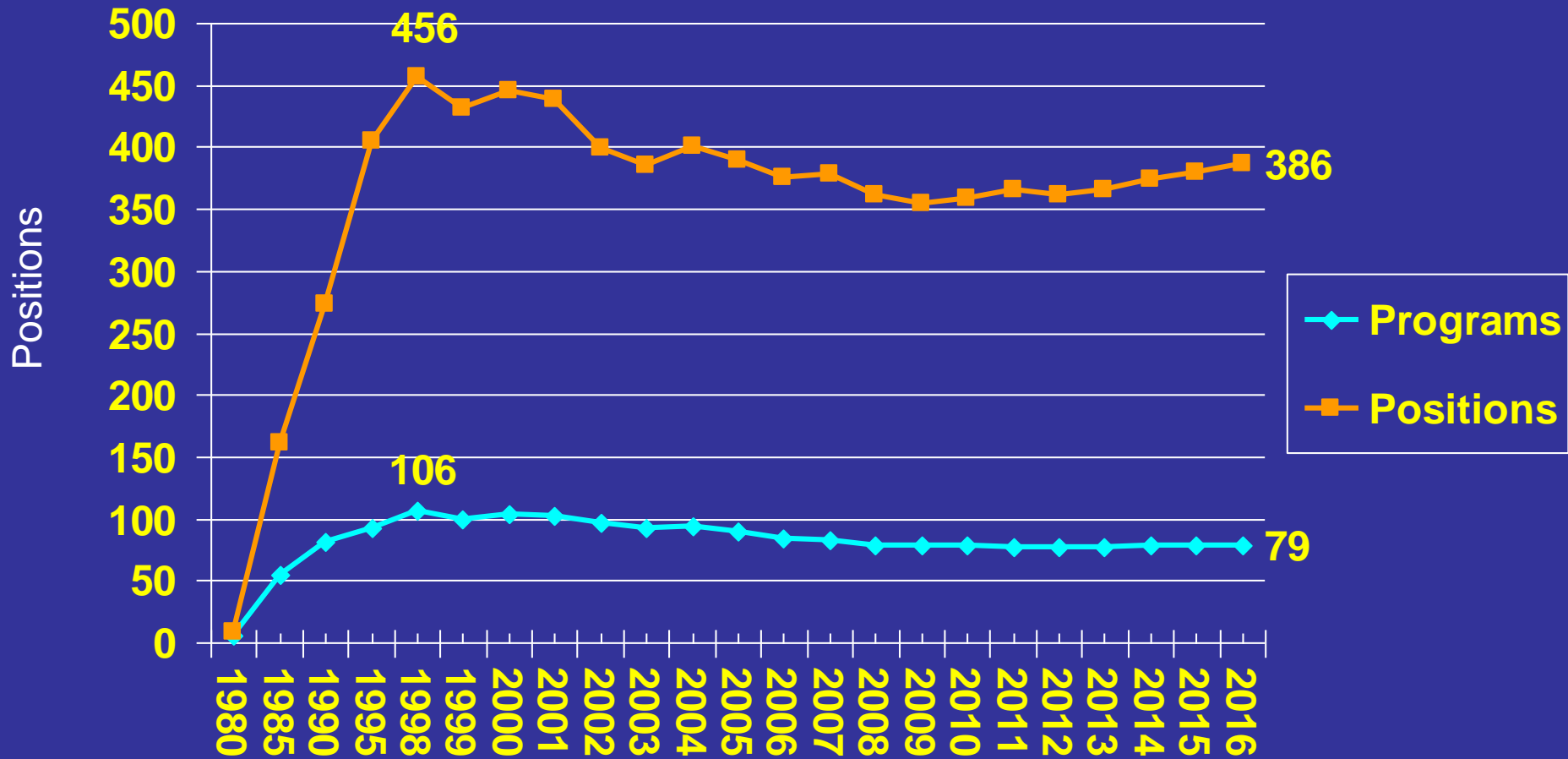

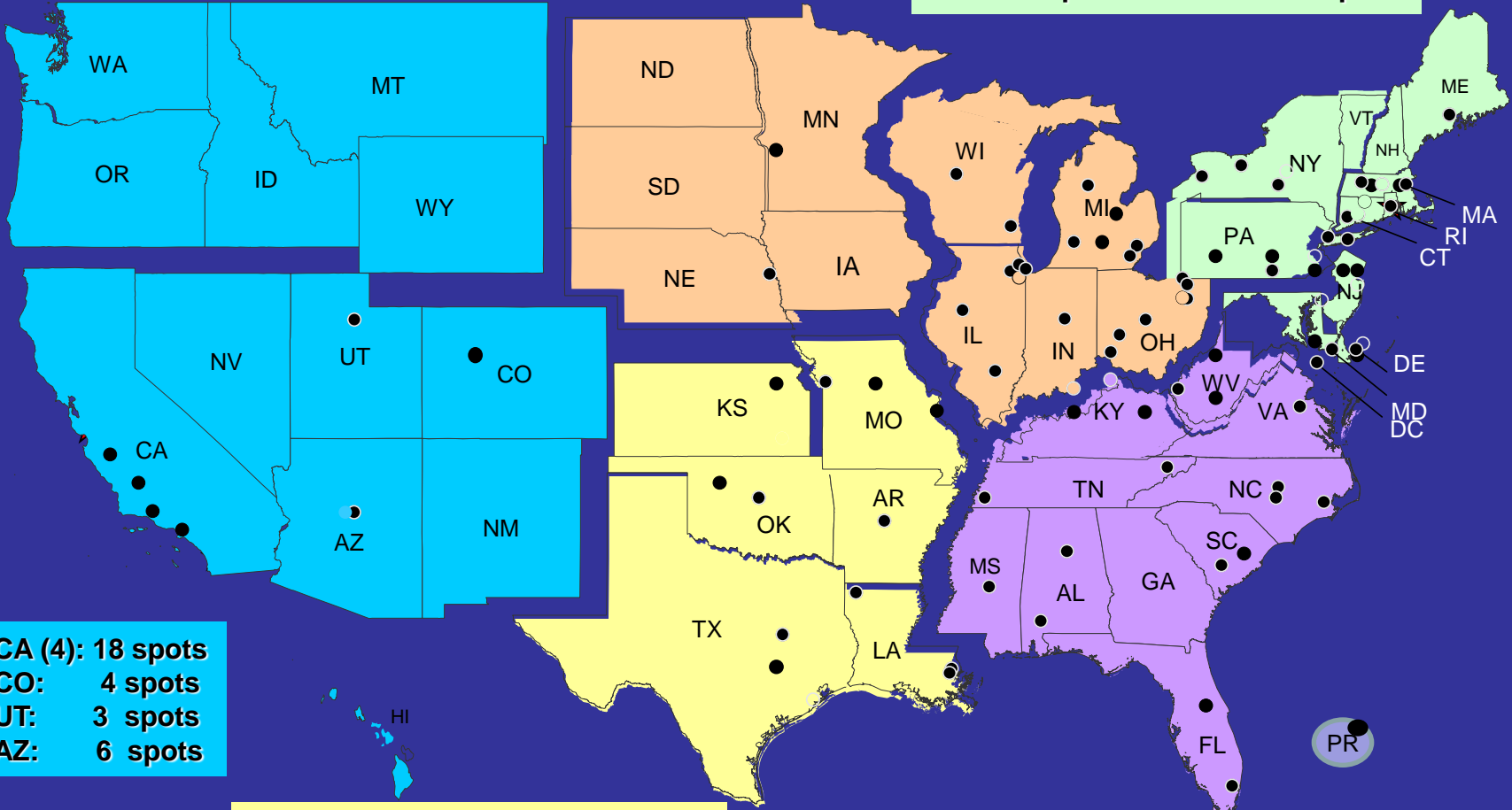

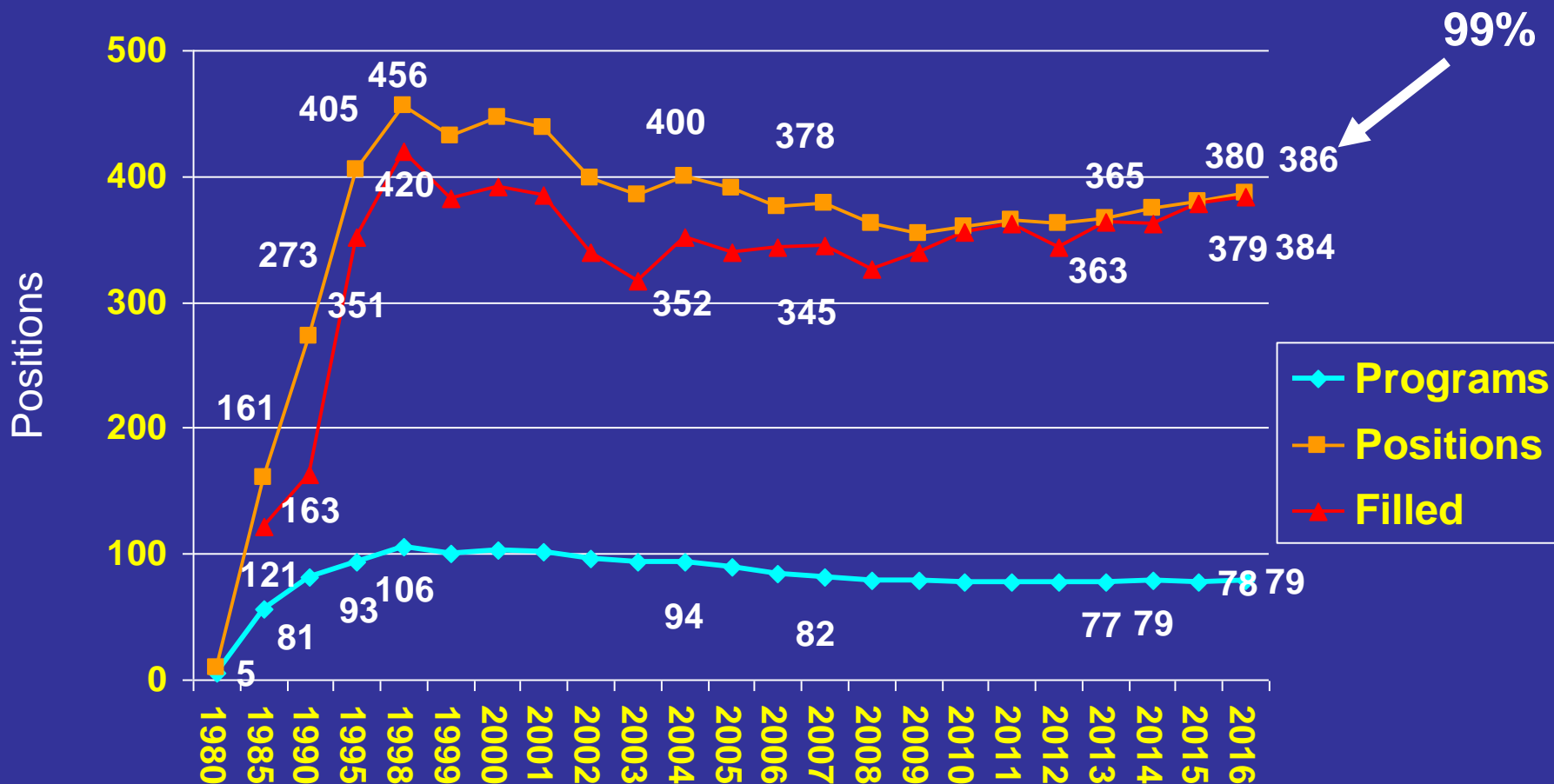

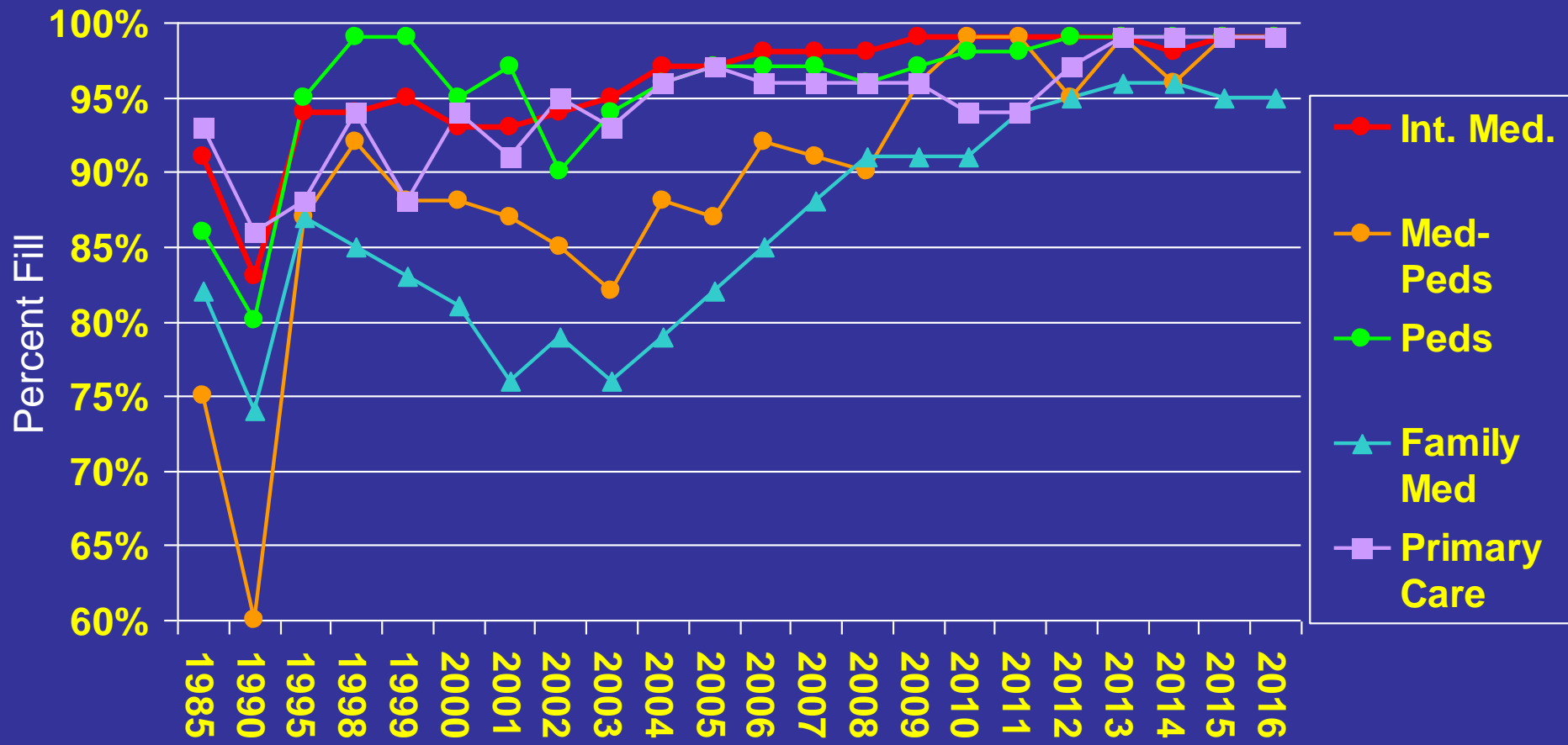

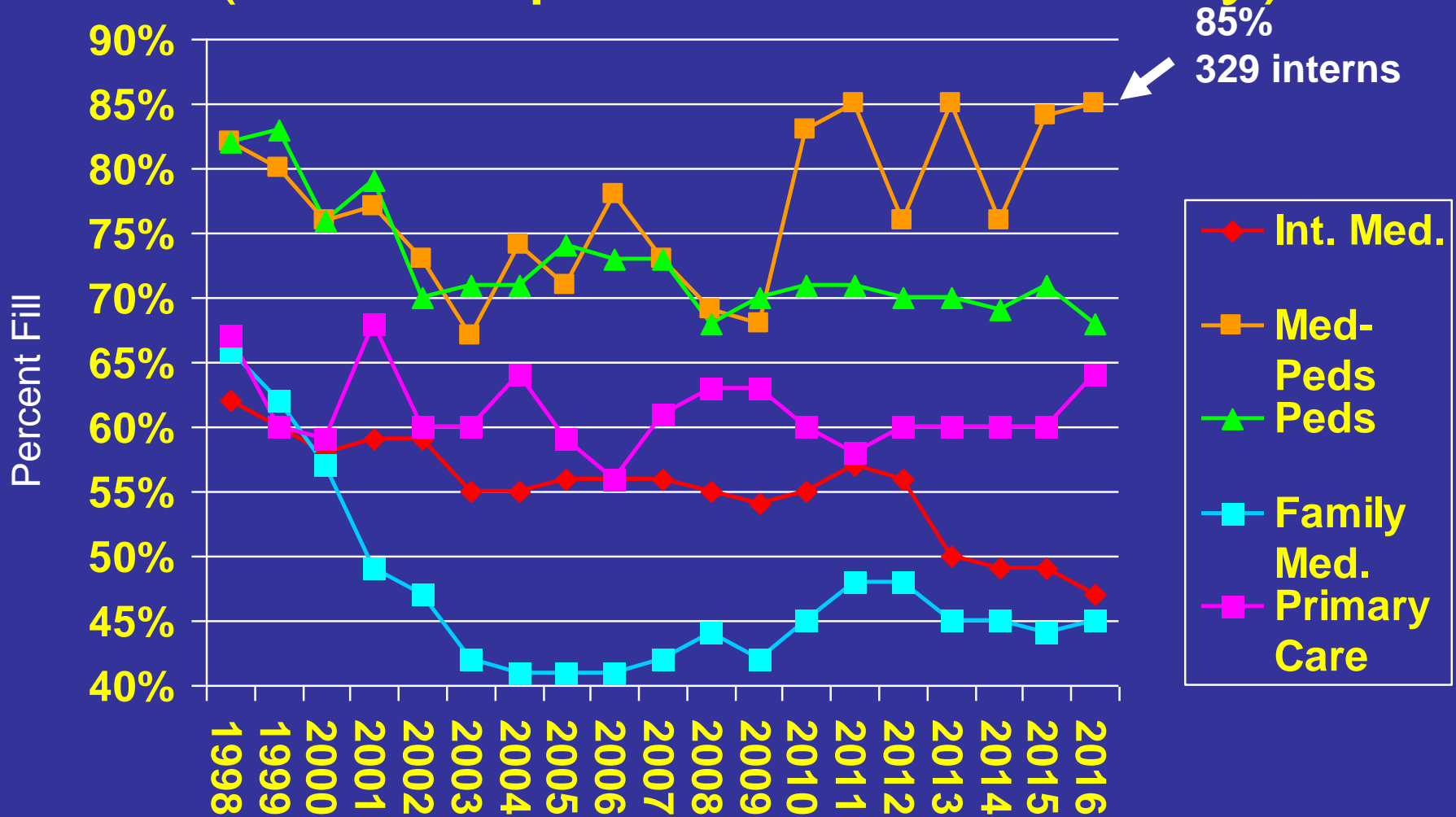
Overall Fill Rates By Residency In NRMP Match (US and IMG)

allopathic graduates?

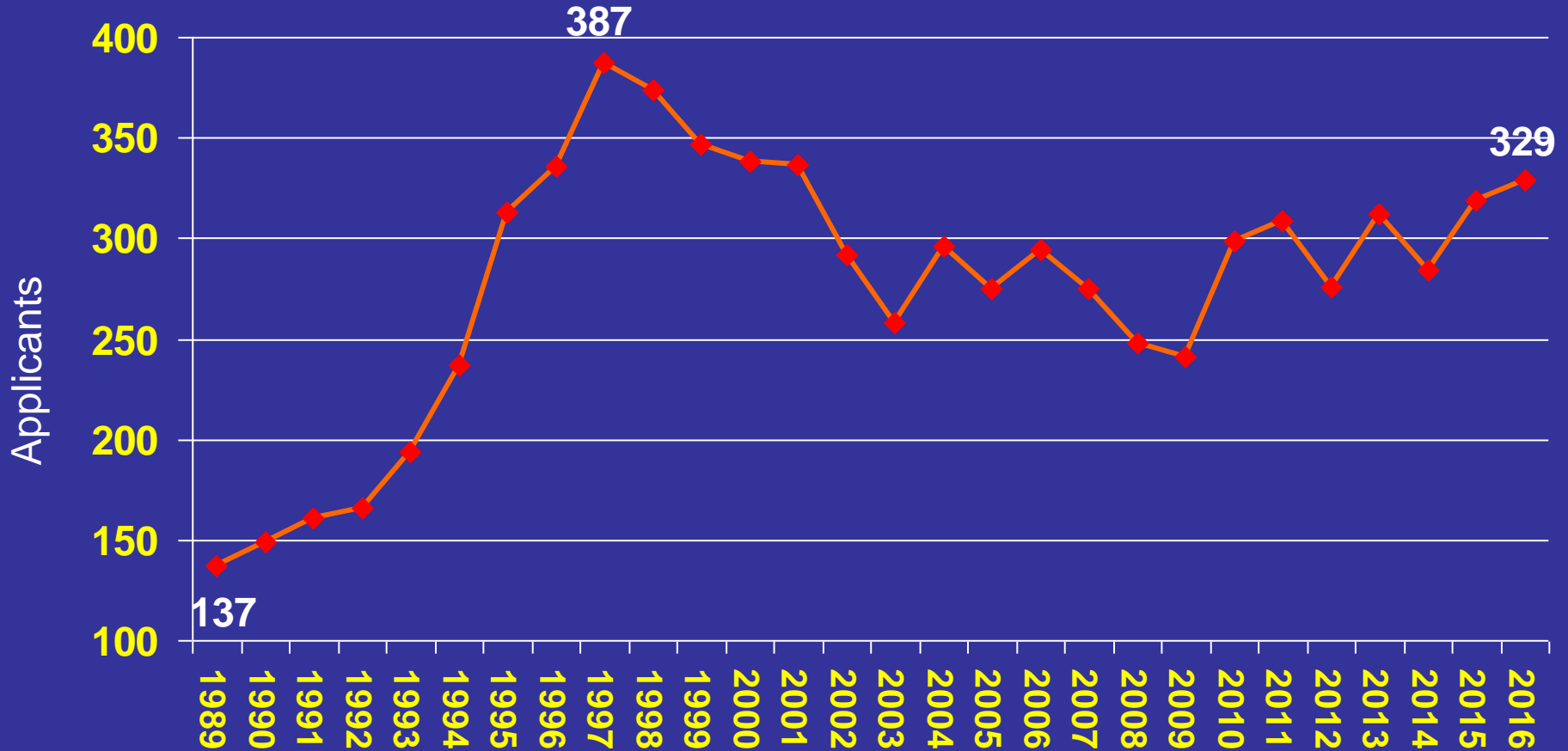

US Graduates (allopathic) Matched into Med-Peds



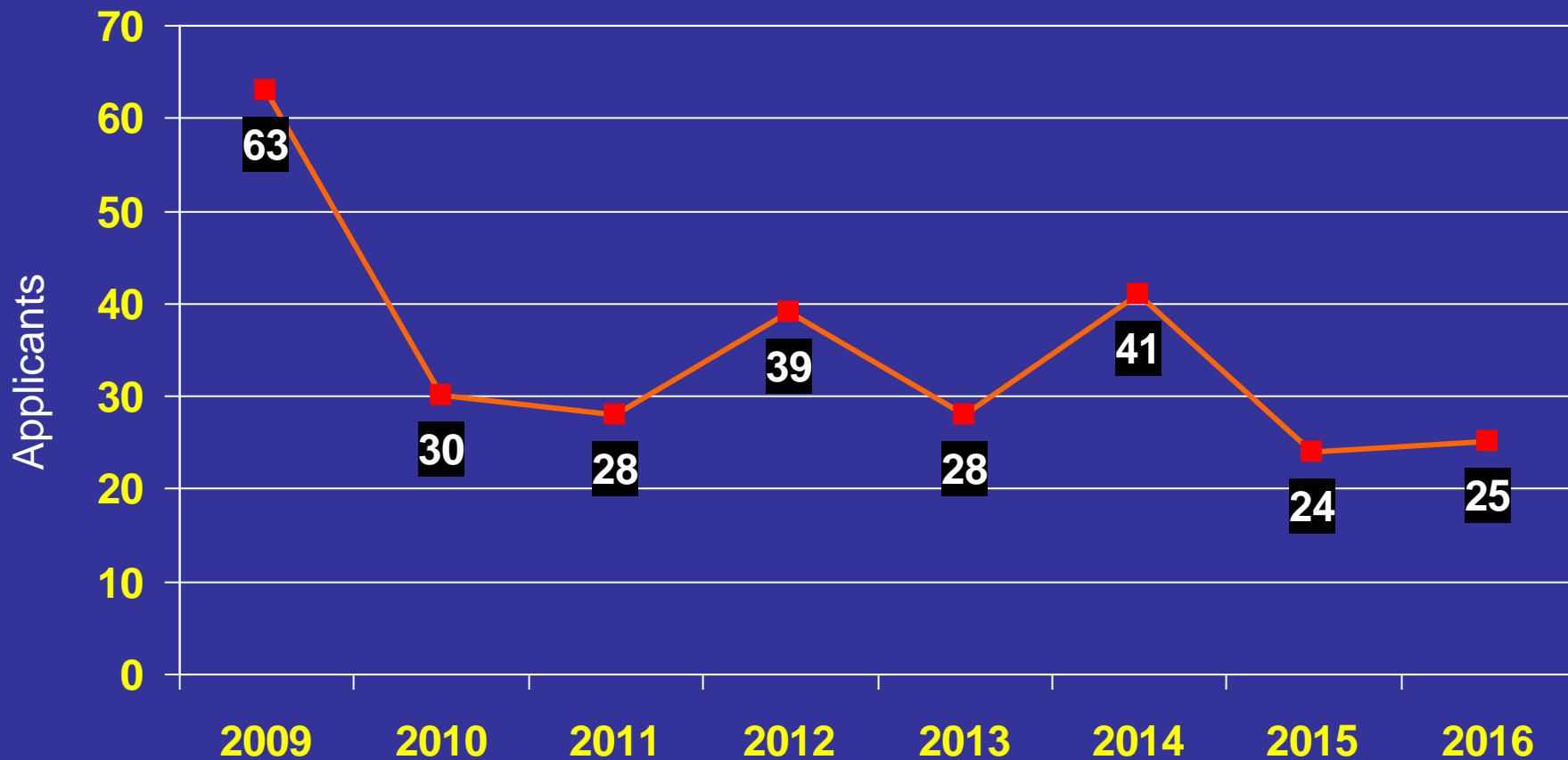
National Resident Matching Program 1989-2016

US Graduates (Osteopathic) Matched into Med-Peds (N = 291 from 2004-2016)



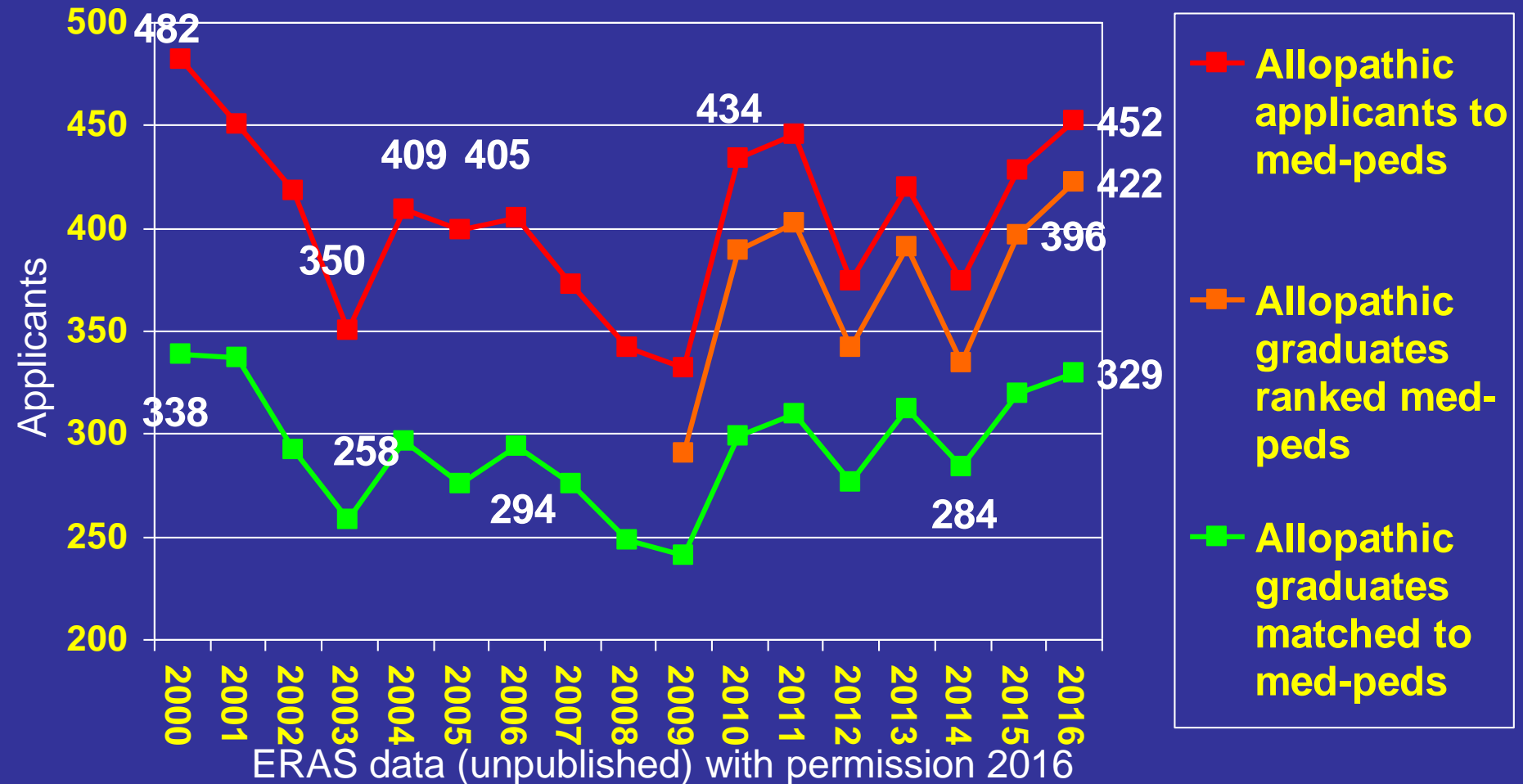
National Resident Matching Program 2004-2016

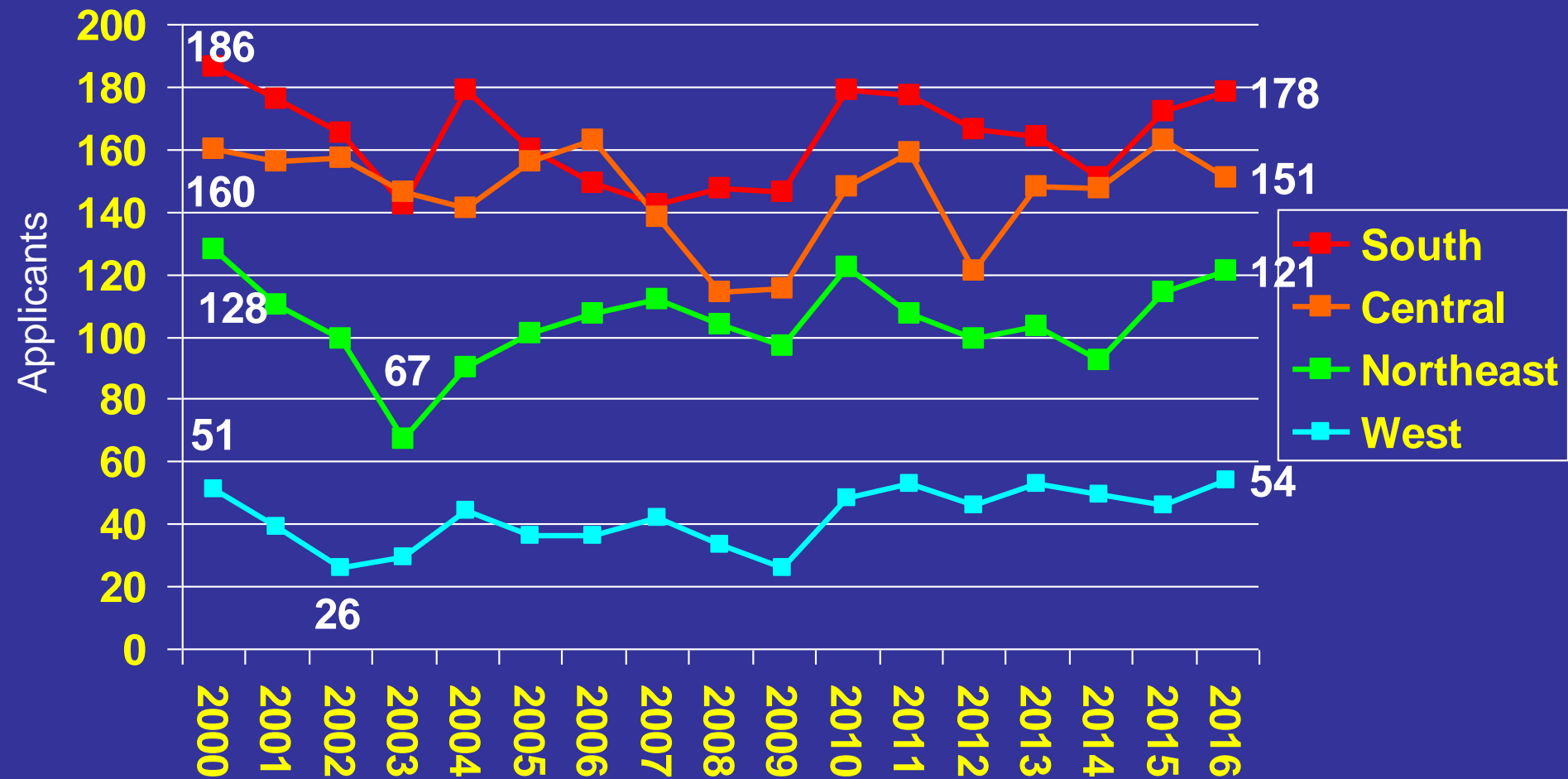
Total Allopathic Applicants to ERAS Compared to Those That Rank and Match into Med-Peds (NRMP)

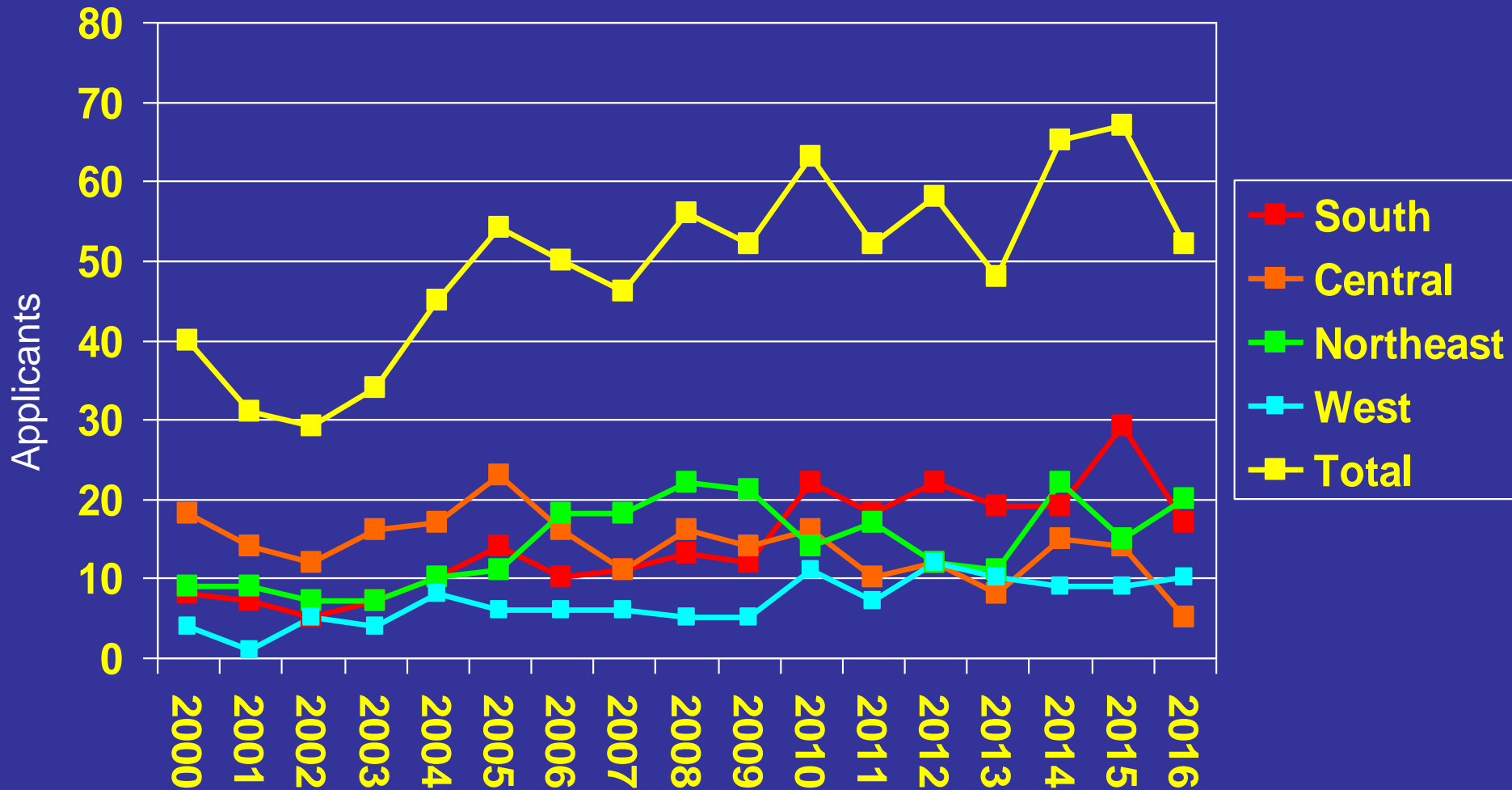

ERAS Applicants to Med-Peds U.S. Graduates (Allopathic and Osteopathic) by Region



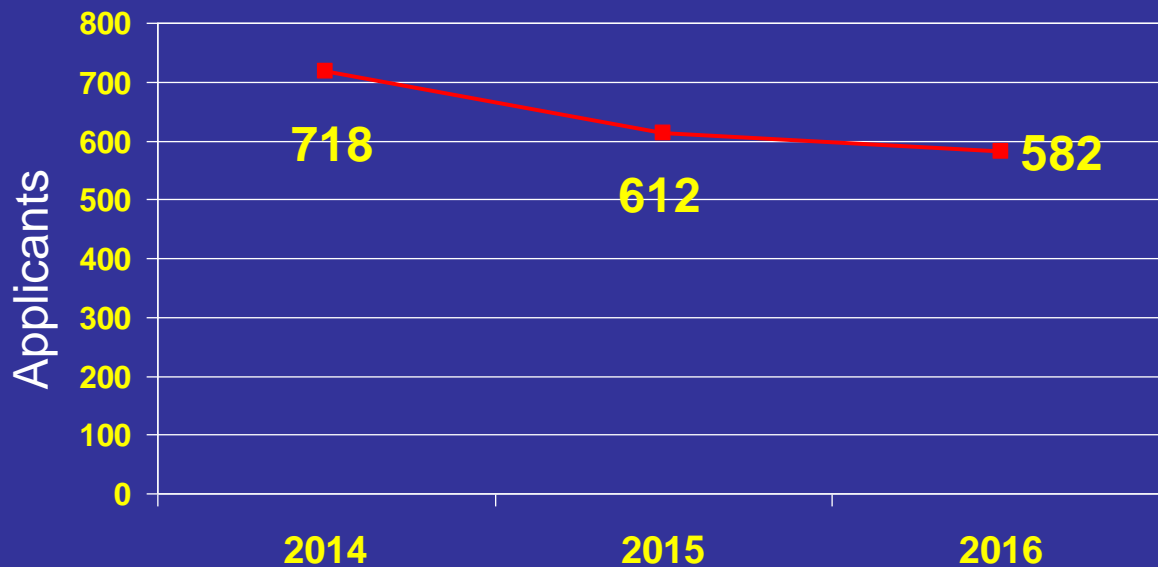

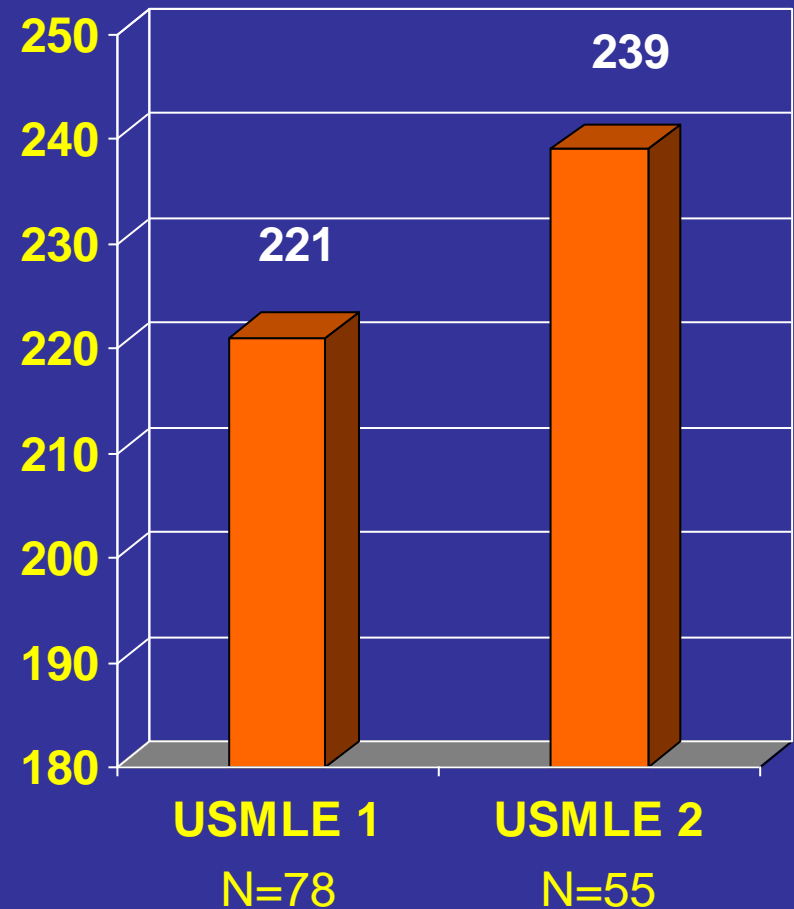
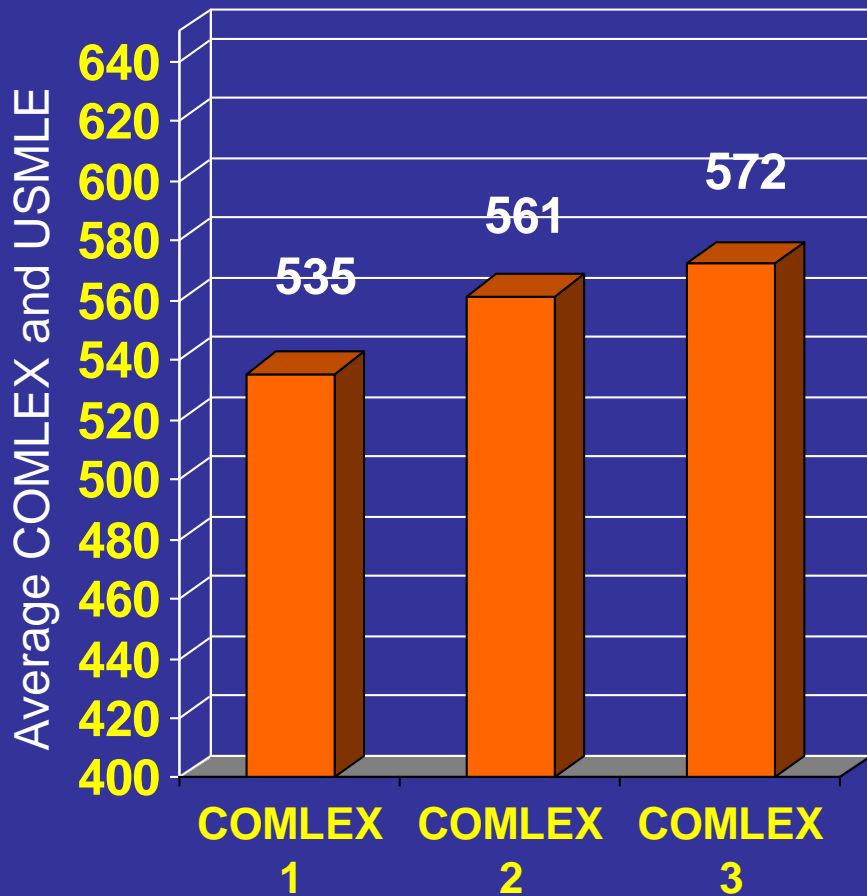
