COPAC: The Council of Program Administrators and Coordinators.

The mission of the Council of Program Administrators and Coordinators is to serve as an information resource for graduate medical education administrators and

coordinators in matters affecting medical education. COPAC's emphasis focuses on information sharing among colleagues in various specialties; understanding accreditation issues and the ACGME; effectively managing the ERAS and NRMP systems; and developing effective relationships with colleagues and resident physicians. AHME

recognizes that residency coordinators provide support that is integral to the operation of residency training programs. These individuals comprise an important segment of GME staffs nationwide. COPAC was established to provide these individuals with a source for information and idea sharing.
