The Association of Med Peds Program Administrators was formally established and organized in 2010 by Kelly Barnes with much support and encouragement from the MPPDA

AMPPA began with 14 original members and in 6 short years, we have grown to 67 members, with nearly 30 PAs attending this meeting.



A membership process was established along with an Executive Committee and 3 sub-committees with 2-3 members each

The Executive Committee consists of the President, President-Elect, Immediate Past President and all sub-committee members.

Members of each sub-committee are asked to serve at least 2 years in order maintain continuity within each committee.




Membership/Mentoring Committee

- Maintains an up-to-date listing of Med Peds program administrators – there are currently over 80 names on that list
 - Of those 80+ names, 67 are members of AMPPA
 - Mentors are solicited for new members upon request – pairing by residency management systems used and size of program
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


Communications Committee
